

Student Made Test (CPEA)

Please see below the procedures for assigning the **Student Made Test**.

1. Teacher assigns topic for students to write item or set of items in groups or individually.
2. The solution for the item(s) must be given.
3. The items are reviewed by the teacher for the following:
 - Matches content assigned
 - Appropriate for Grade level (5or6)
 - Structure is semantically and grammatically correct
 - Correct solution/answer is provided
 - Marks are appropriately allocated.

NB: *These items after review by the teacher may be used on Teacher-Made Test*

Criteria					Score
Grade Level (2 marks)	Item(s) is at a level of Grade 5 or 6	2	Students write items/questions but not at the appropriate level.	1	
Content/Structure (4 Marks)	The items are well constructed and match content area	3-4	The items match the content but with some error in structure	1-2	
Solution/Answer (4 Marks)	All/Most solutions are correct with marks clearly allocated	3-4	Some solutions are correct and marks not clearly allocated	1-2	
Total 10 Marks					

Teachers should ensure that there are opportunities for students:

- **To discuss the task**
- **To do peer reviews of items**
- **Teacher should also ensure that items are directly copied from textbooks or other sources.**
