Participants of the 12th edition of the revived Windward Islands Schools Games which took place in St Vincent and the Grenadines during the period 26 July – 4 August 2013 have expressed their joy at what emerged as perhaps the most closely contested edition of the annual sports festival. There was no sporting event that did not exceed the expectations of the participating countries with the fortunes changing quite frequently during the period of competition.

The decision of the Local Organising Committee to decentralise the Games of 2013 received high commendation from the Manager of the Dominican team, Mr Yehudi John, when he made his brief presentation at the closing ceremony at the Games Village. Mr John expressed his own appreciation and profound gratitude for having had the opportunity to see much more of St Vincent than in his two previous visits (2005, 2009) when we hosted the Games.

The peoples of Park Hill, Keartons and Questelles relished their involvement in the hosting of the Windward Islands Schools Games for the very first time and the visitors enjoyed playing under different conditions in the several communities visited.

The Local Organising Committee (LOC) received kudos from everyone for the tremendous work undertaken for the realisation of the Games of 2013 in virtually all areas. Particularly noticeable were the commendations for the innovations of the LOC this year. The innovations included:

Decentralisation of the competitions

- o A Games logo
- o Indoor Opening Ceremony
- o A theme – Four Teams, One Dream,
- o A catch phrase – The Place where Legends are born
- o Individual opening ceremonies for each sport
- o Daily meetings between the Local Organising

Committee (LOC) and the management of each of the participating teams for monitoring and control of all aspects of the Games.

The Games Village, The West St George Secondary, proved a worthy facility for the assignment and provided a secure and safe environment for the delegations that was readily appreciated and played host to both the opening and closing ceremonies with an atmosphere equal to the excitement created by the on-field competition.

The Windward Islands Schools Games 2013 are now over but the rich legacy of its success will hover for years to come. The athletes will long remember the keenness of the competition and intensity of the friendly rivalry on the field and the camaraderie that endeared all to each other. St Vincent and the Grenadines is the better for having been proud hosts and for having engaged in a review of the existing mode of operation enough to submit comprehensive proposals for the sustainability and development of the Games in the future.
